



## Borough of Lemoyne Comprehensive Recreation, Park, and Open Space Talking Points

Citizens are invited to attend a public meeting on October 21, at Memorial Park to learn more about the Implementable Comprehensive Recreation, Park and Open Space Plan. ### Questionnaire

In mid-October, the Borough of Lemoyne will be distributing a digital questionnaire (also available in paper, upon request) that adults in the Borough may complete to share their opinions.

The questionnaire will be one form of citizen participation in an Implementable Comprehensive Recreation, Park and Open Space Plan process. As this plan is developed and eventually finalized, it will become the Borough's policy guide for "where do we want to go?" and "how do we get there?" Municipalities typically revise their plans every 10 years.

### Implementable Plan

An Implementable Comprehensive Recreation, Park and Open Space Plan is a policy guide (not a law or ordinance) that provides a framework for Township decision-making for the next five to 10 years. The plan will set out solutions to problems and help guide the Borough regarding how it wants to improve recreation, trails and connectivity, and green infrastructure.
